The Value of Life Insurance for Children

As a parent, you worry about your children and do everything you can to protect them. You try to raise them right and make sure they are prepared to become adults. But have you ever thought about buying life insurance for your child?

The 40 Days for Life Campaign began September 25: What is it and what has it accomplished? Read on... 40 Days for Life began in Bryan/College Station in 2004. The first nationally coordinated 40 Days for Life was in 2007. This simple and highly effective campaign has been the channel of great miracles:

- Over **700 cities in all 50 states** and multiple countries have conducted a 40 day prayer vigil at the local abortion facility.
- At least **45 different countries** have conducted a 40 day prayer vigil including Argentina, Armenia, Australia, Belize, Brazil, Canada, Congo, Croatia, Denmark, England, Georgia, Germany, Ghana, Ireland, Latvia, Mexico, New Zealand, Nigeria, Northern Ireland, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Russia, South Africa, Spain, Uganda, and Wales.
- Over **13,000 women** haven chosen life for children they were going to abort since 2007 – because of the peaceful presence of people in front of the abortion facilities.
- At least **150 workers** in abortion facilities have had conversions and quit their jobs.
- At least **85 abortion facilities** have closed their doors and shut down for good.
- Thousands upon thousands of men and women with abortions in their past have **finally found healing**.

On the Federal Pro-Life front: The Senate withdrew its latest attempt to improve healthcare for Americans and defund Panned Parenthood because at least three Republicans and all Democrats in the Senate said they would vote against the Bill.

Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act. **Call your elected officials to get this Bill passed.**

House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy, and half a dozen Members of Congress outside the U.S. Capitol announced that the House will vote on the Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act a week from today on Tuesday, October 3rd. The Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act would ban abortions after 5 months, a point by which science shows unborn children feel pain. The bill actually passed through the house in the last Congress (2015). But we need to pass it again through the House and send it to the Senate to build momentum to get it to the President's desk!" Marjorie Dannenfelser, SBA List.

As early as eight to ten weeks after conception, and definitely by thirteen-and-a-half weeks, the unborn experiences organic pain.... First, the unborn child's mouth, at eight weeks, then her hands at ten weeks, then her face, arms, and legs at eleven weeks become sensitive to touch. By thirteen-and-a-half weeks, she responds to pain at all levels of her nervous system in an integrated response which cannot be termed a mere reflex. She can now experience pain. Surgeon Robert P.
